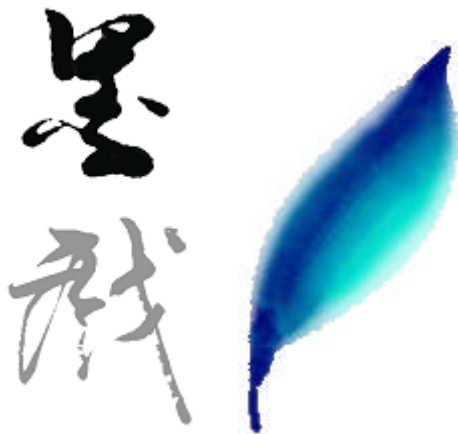

(Joint school Visit with Wah Yan College, Hong Kong)

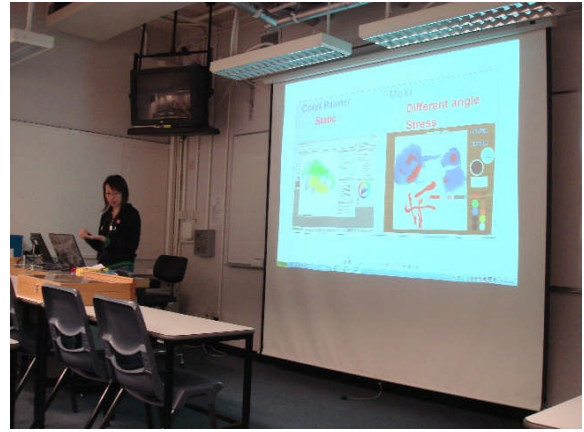
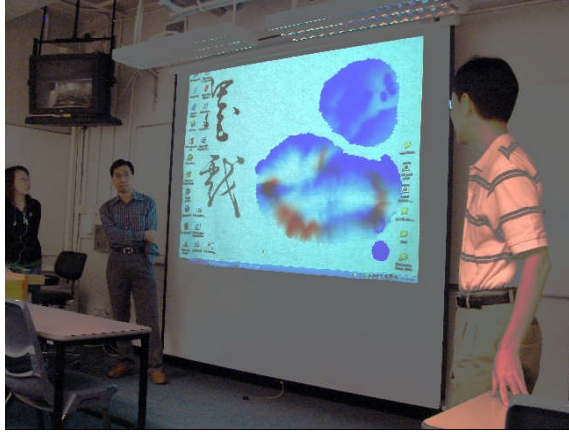

Lastly, we took a group photo at the entrance of the university before the visit ended.

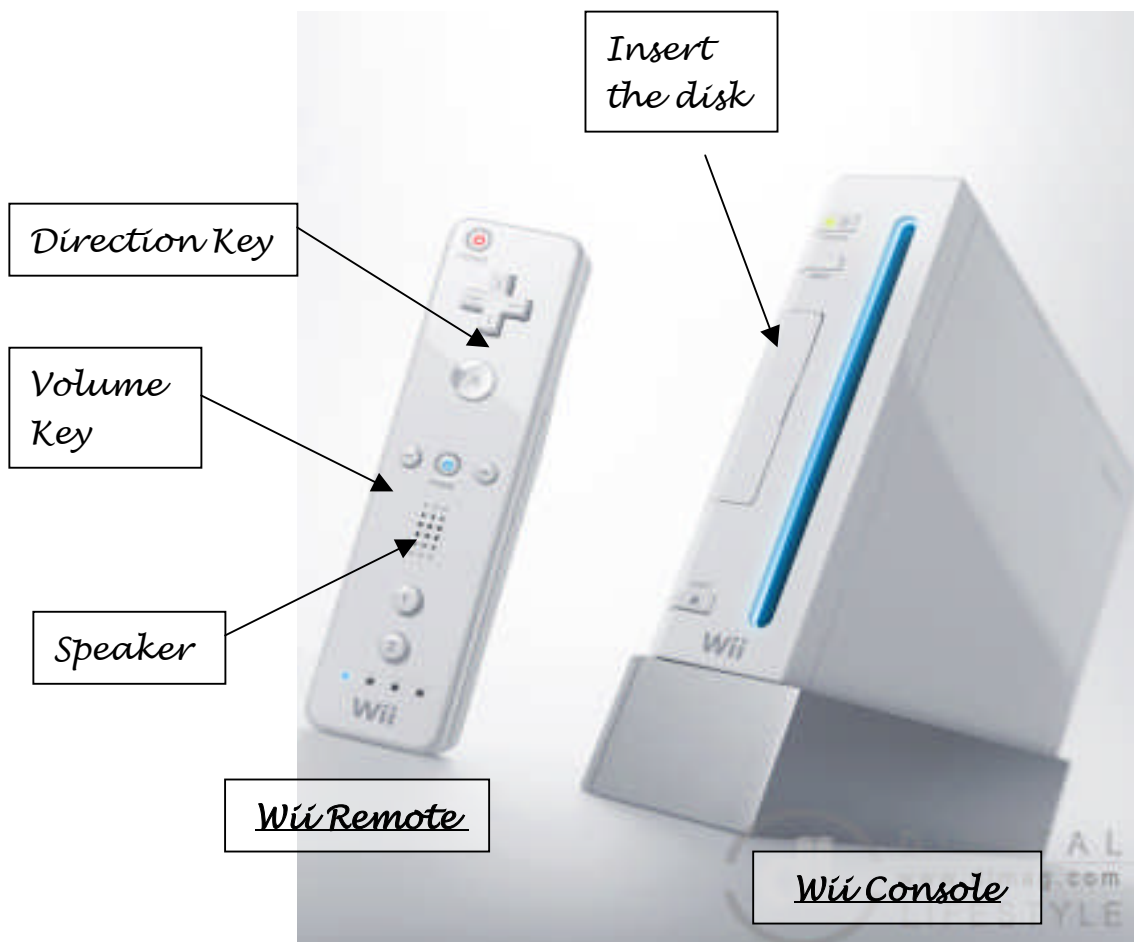


International Games Programming - Wii



Wii (pronounced as the pronoun "we") is the fifth video game console released by Nintendo. It competes with Microsoft's Xbox 360 and Sony's PlayStation 3, the other two consoles in seventh generation.

For the choice of this name, Nintendo said,
"Wii sounds like 'we', which emphasizes that the console is for everyone.
Wii can easily be remembered by people around the world, no matter what language they speak. No confusion. No need to abbreviate. Just Wii."



- Wii is the smallest and lightest among the three seventh generation consoles
- The console can be placed either horizontally or vertically

Wii Remote

The Wii remote is different from the traditional controller. Its special design allows users to control the game using physical gestures as well as traditional button presses.



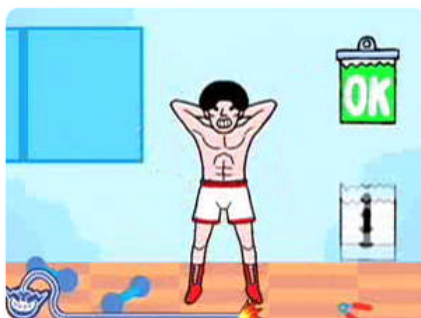
- *Shaker*



- *Accelerometer - controls the cursor on the screen*





- *Infrared detector - senses its position in 3D space*




Internet Features of Wii

Acting as a video entertainment computer, users can get access to the Internet via WiiConnect24, which enables it to receive messages and updates over the Internet.

Wii Channel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> acts as a remote control of the television, switching it to different channels. 	
Wii Shop Channel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wii Points allow users to download newly added channels and video games for the Virtual Console. Wii Points can be purchased and redeemed in the this channel. 	
Forecast Channel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> allows weather reports and forecasts to be downloaded from the Internet via the WiiConnect24 service. 	
News Channel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> allows users to access news headlines and current events obtained from the Internet. 	
Parental Control	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> prohibits younger users from playing games with content considered unsuitable for their age levels 	

Other Features...

Photo Channel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> allows user to view photos(JPEG) in a SD card. a built-in editor allows users to add markings and effects to their photos. 	
Disc Channel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> allows users to play Wii and Nintendo GameCube titles. 	
Mii Channel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> users can design 3D characters with different facial and bodily features by this avatar creator. The character can later be used by gameware. 	
Nintendo DS connectivity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> supports wireless connectivity with the Nintendo DS 	

Comparison between Xbox 360, PlayStation 3 and Wii

Nintendo Wii is the third video game console released in the seventh generation. Compare with the other two consoles, *Microsoft* Xbox 360 and *Sony* PlayStation 3, their price, media, etc. vary from different aspects.

Meanwhile, these three consoles compete with each other on some levels.

Functions for the general public

Highlight Search Terms

If you've used the Google Toolbar to find a web page, the Highlight button instantly lights them up on the page!

Word Find Buttons

Finding a particular word on a web page?
Typing your word into the Toolbar search box, then clicking on the Toolbar's Word Find button to find each additional occurrence of the word.

Enhanced Search Box

- See a list of useful suggestions for your search query based on popular Google searches,
- Spelling corrections
- Your own Toolbar search history and bookmarks

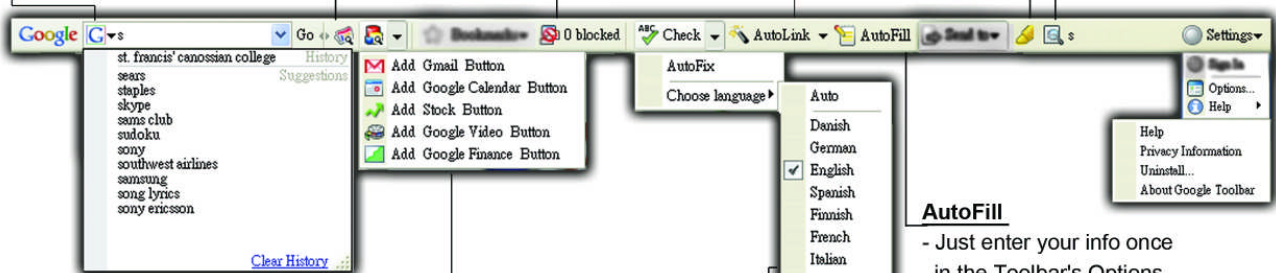
Autolink

- When clicking the Toolbar's AutoLink button will automatically create a link to an online map (US addresses only, unfortunately).

Pop-up Blocker

- keeps your screen free and clear.

Google News



Custom Buttons

- It offers a selection of ready-made buttons for popular sites, and you can make your own buttons in seconds by right-clicking within the search box on any site and selecting "Generate Custom Search..."

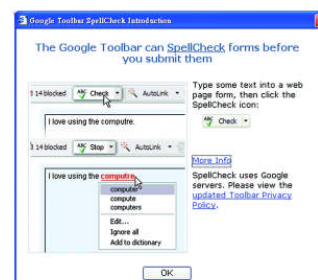


AutoFill

- Just enter your info once in the Toolbar's Options dialog box and enables you to fill out web forms with a single click.
(Note: your credit card info stays password-protected.)

SpellCheck

- It finds any spelling mistakes whenever you type into a web form, including web-based email, discussion forums, and intranet web applications.
- The AutoFix option corrects all of your text with a single click.

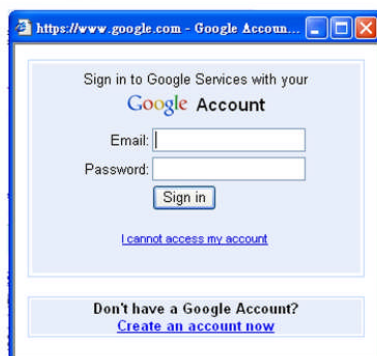

Functions for the registered users of Google



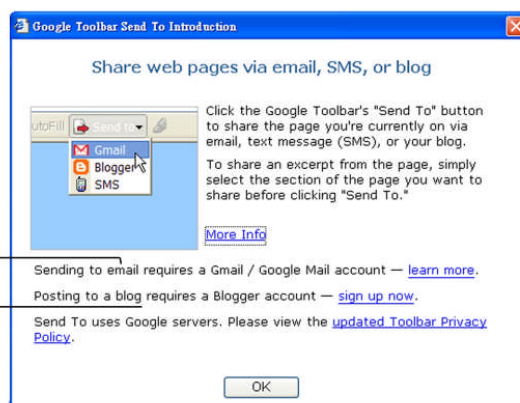
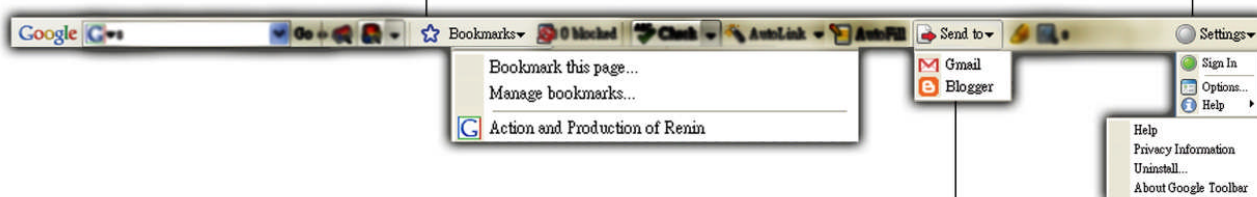

You can now sign in and out right from your Toolbar. Click on the Settings button on the right end of the Toolbar and select "Sign In". (you'll know you're signed in when the Toolbar shows you a green light, as shown).  Settings

Bookmarks

Click the Toolbar's star icon, or right-click the star to add and label a bookmark.



Send To

Use your Google Toolbar to share web pages via email, text message (SMS), or blog. To share an entire page, select from the Toolbar's "Send To" menu; to share an excerpt, simply select the section of the page you want to share before clicking "Send To."

Introducing the **YAHOO!** TOOLBAR

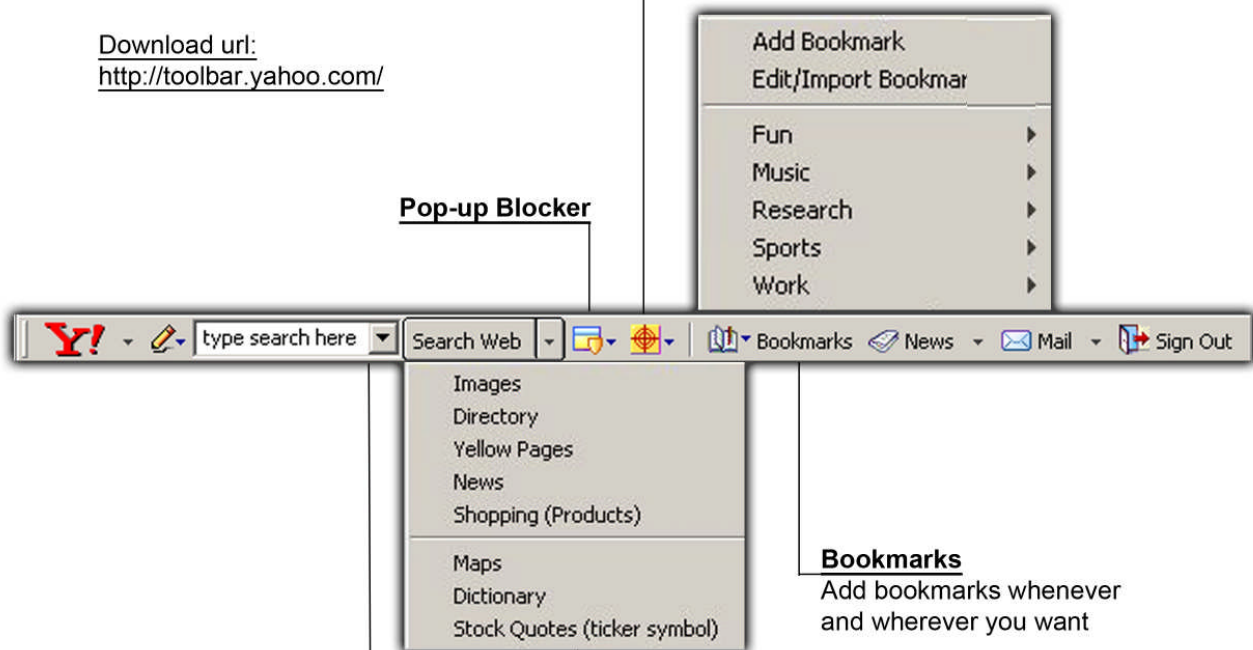

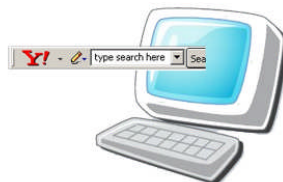
